If the nearest noun phrase is <u>singular</u>, the verb is <u>singular</u>; if the nearest phrase is <u>plural</u>, the verb is <u>plural</u>.

Agreement on the verb in 'there be' clauses is determined by the <u>**number**</u> of the nearest noun phrase.
