## Target Students: Junior Secondary

## Corpus Used: wordandphrase

Teaching Goal: After this 45-minute class, students can understand the meaning of cost, spend, pay, and more importantly, they can develop integrated language skills of using them in different context.

## Warm up section (5 mins)

Task type: Individual work
Focused Skill: Listening, word meaning

1.1. Watch the 2-minute video and try to understand the dialogue. While watching, students are supposed to pay special attention to these three words: cost, spend and pay, and noting down the sentences is preferred.

1.2. Teacher shows the sentences appeared on the video with cost, spend and pay. Then ask students try to deduct the meaning of them. In this part, teacher also can know students' preknowledge on form, meaning and usage of the three words, so that teacher can arrange the rest tasks flexibly.

Task type: class work, individual work
Focused skil: grammatical skill

### 3.1 Presentation

One member from each group is supposed to give presentation to the class and tell the class what words the group have found.
Meanwhile, other groups will look at the concordance lines, make supplements and give judgement.

### 3.2 Discussion

Students will discuss in groups about the word class and sentence structure.
After discussion, teacher will ask students what formats or usage they have found, and write them in the chart.

### 3.3 Teacher's conclusion

Teacher will give a conclusion on how to use the three words in shopping context.

## Summary:

1. Cost will normally be used in a sentence starting with $\qquad$ they/something , which refers to the object you paid money for.
Third person + cost/costs + price/time + (to do sth.)
2. Spend will normally be used in a sentence starting with Personal Pronoun/Name $\qquad$ , like I, He, She, They.
Personal Pronoun/Name + spend/spent + price/time + doing sth.
3. Pay will normally be used in a sentence starting with $\qquad$ Pronoun/Name $\qquad$ , like I, He, She, They.
Personal Pronoun/Name + pay/paid + price + for sth.

Activity - Flea Market Sharing

Instruction: Students should bring what he/she bought in the flea market and share them in groups using cost, spend and pay. Then some students will be required to share in front of the class.
