How to understand this list?

- 1. For the most frequent features found in groups with higher band scores (7.0 7.5 and 8.0 or above), they are either (a) positive features which may lead to higher band scores, or (b) negative features which may have minimal effect on the overall performance.
- 2. For the most frequent features found in groups with lower band scores (5.0 5.5 and 6.0 6.5), they are either (a) negative features which may lead to lower band scores, or (b) positive features which may have minimal effect on the overall performance.
