Tone 3 Combination

- ▶ Tone 3 + Tone 1
- ▶ Tone 3 + Tone 2
- ▶ Tone 3 + Tone 3
(read as Tone 2 + Tone 3)
- ▶ Tone 3 + Tone 4
- ▶ Tone 3 + Tone 0

Tone 3 Combination

► In Praat, Open > Read from file... > 5th Workshop > Audio > Male/Female > Worksheet 5.1 > 'xi3huan1', 'wan3xia2', 'zong3tong3', 'shu3xiang4' and 'zha3ba0'

1. Separate two sounds
2. Write down measurements
3. Record your own reading
4. Compare
5. Re-record and improve

Tone 4 Combination

- ▶ Tone 4 + Tone 1
- ▶ Tone 4 + Tone 2
- ▶ Tone 4 + Tone 3
- ▶ Tone 4 + Tone 4
- ▶ Tone 4 + Tone 0

Tone 4 Combination

► In Praat, Open > Read from file... > 5th Workshop > Audio > Male/Female > Worksheet 5.2 > ‘xia4tian1’, ‘shan4chang2’, ‘huo4xu3’, ‘dong4dong4’, and ‘wei4zhi0’

1. Separate two sounds
2. Write down measurements
3. Record your own reading
4. Compare
5. Re-record and improve
